INTRODUCTION

The hospital has been awarded NABH accreditation in 2018 and was the first to get an ISO certification in the district of Malappuram.

The Edappal Hospitals – Nursing College is affiliated to Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur and is recognized by the Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council and Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi.

OVERVIEW OF B.Sc. NURSING COURSE

The B.Sc. Nursing Degree program is a four-year fulltime program comprising eight semesters, specified by Kerala University of Health Sciences, (KUHS), approved by Indian Nursing Council (INC) & Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council (KNMC), which prepares B.Sc. Nursing graduates qualified to practice nursing and midwifery in a variety of settings in either public/ government or private healthcare settings.

NUMBER OF SEATS: 40 Seats Per Year

- Government Quota: 20 seats (50 % of total seats)
- Management Quota: 20 seats (50 % of total seats)

ALLOTMENT OF SEATS

- Government Quota: 20 seats (50 % of total seats)

Government seats are those which the Director of Medical Education makes allotments. Admission to these seats will be made on the basis of merit. Admission process of allotment to Government merit seats (50%) under Edappal Hospitals – Nursing College will be done by the Director, LBS Centre for Science & Technology, under the supervision of the Director of Medical Education, as per the G.O (MS) No. 75/2018/H&FWD dated, 18/05/2018. Candidates are requested to visit the official website of LBS Centre www.lbscentre.kerala.gov.in for details

- Management Quota: 20 seats (50 % of total seats)

These are the seats, other than Government seats (50%), against which the Edappal Hospitals – Nursing College will make allotment. There will not be any type of reservation in the Management seats. Candidate shall pay the Tuition fees and Special fees, fixed by the Government. The eligibility for admission is same as for Government quota and the candidate will be selected on merit basis. Candidates can apply online through college website www.ehnc.in.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Candidates seeking admission for B.Sc. Nursing course should fulfill the following:

Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary examination conducted by Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, or examination equivalent thereto as approved by Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur. Should have separate minimum pass mark for Physics, Chemistry and Biology and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology put together.

Applicant should have completed 17 years of age on the 31st December 2023. For the proof of age, self-attested copy of relevant page of school record with date of birth such as SSLC/ CBSE/ ICSE certificate or copy of birth certificate from appropriate authority should be furnished along with the application form.

**Applicants who have passed the qualifying examination from the universities/ boards outside Kerala shall produce the eligibility certificate from KUHS and Migration certificate from the universities/ boards concerned.

DURATION OF THE COURSE

Duration of the B.Sc. Nursing course shall be four years, which is a credit and semester-based program, comprising of eight semesters including Internship. The maximum period to complete the B.Sc. Nursing course successfully shall not exceed twice the actual duration of the course (Eight years).

HOW TO APPLY

- Application for admission and prospectus are available ONLINE through college website. Visit www.ehnc.in for details.
- The application fee is Rs.800/- for all candidates, payable through online. The candidate should have a valid e-mail id.
- After online payment of application fee, fill up all necessary information and upload details of marks, necessary documents, photo, application fee transfer details signature of parent/guardian and applicant.
- Submission of more than one application by a candidate will lead to rejection of the candidature.
- Application fee once remitted will not be refunded in any circumstances. Incomplete/belated applications will be rejected.

SELECTION OF CANDIDATES

Selection of candidates will be based on merit list prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in plus two or qualifying examination. Candidates should bring all the documents in original for verification at the time of admission. Any false information will lead to cancellation of admission.

Preparation of merit list

Marks of Physics, Chemistry and Biology in Higher Secondary Examination* will be considered for preparation of merit list. If there is a tie, marks of Biology will be taken, followed by Physics and Chemistry. If all these are equal Date of Birth of candidate will be considered ie, with person of higher age getting preference over the younger.

* CBSE/ ICSE Senior Secondary Examination marks will be equated with Higher Secondary marks of Kerala syllabus by approved normalization process.

Publication of Rank List

The rank lists will be published in the college website www.ehnc.in on the date notified.

ADMISSION

- Selected candidates will be informed the date and time of interview and admission, in due course, through website
- Candidates are requested to visit the www.ehnc.in regularly for notifications and announcements.
- Selected candidates for admission under Management quota are requested to remit fee into the college account through bank transfer and must bring the fee transaction details.

All the selected students should get themselves vaccinated against Hepatitis B before admission. Certificates to the effect should be produced at the time of admission or before commencement of the course.

Physical Fitness Certificate (Certified by a Registered Medical Practitioner) should be produced at the time of admission or before commencement of the course.

COURSE FEE

The fee structure shown below was fixed by Govt / Fee Regulatory Committee for the 2023 admission. Any revision in the fee structure ordered by the competent authorities for the current academic year will have to be paid by the candidate.

Annual fee is payable at the beginning of academic year during each year of the course. Caution Deposit is refundable after the completion of course on submission of Non-Liability Certificate (NLC).

DISCONTINUATION

- A candidate who gets allotment and admission to a course through Directorate of Medical Education, Kerala for the Academic Year 2023 - 24 will be eligible for full refund of fee remitted and he/she need not pay any liquidated damages up to the date fixed by Government.
- The Candidates admitted against Govt./Management seats in Edappal Hospitals Nursing College, on discontinuance of course in the first year, after the cut-off date for closing of admissions fixed by the Govt./INC/KNMC/KUHS are liable to pay liquidated damages and the same shall be collected as per the final decision of the AFRC/Court of Law. In case of discontinuation of the course the certificate and TC shall be released on getting a bond executed by the student with one of his/her parents undertaking that they shall obey the orders that may be passed by the AFRC or Court of Law.
- Candidates admitted against Government seats in Govt./Management seats in Edappal Hospitals Nursing College who discontinue the course after the first academic year, are liable to pay liquidated damages equal to the total amount of tuition fee payable for the remaining year(s) of study. Regarding the discontinuation from the course and cancellation of the admission shall be subject to the legal and factual scrutiny of the AFRC/Court of Law, when any complaint is submitted before the Committee on such matter.

EXAMINATION

- Regular University Examination is conducted at the end of each semester and supplementary examination as notified by KUHS. Examination fees shall be remitted by the candidate as stipulated by the University & college from time to time.

ELIGIBILITY FOR APPEARING EXAMINATION

A candidate must have a minimum of 80% attendance in theory and practical in each subject for appearing for University Examination. A minimum of 80% attendance in all the non-exam going subjects in the concerned semester also is essential for registering a candidate for the university examination.

The candidate must secure 50% marks for internal assessment in theory and practical, wherever is applicable in order to be eligible to appear in the university examination of the subject. Minimum pass mark shall be 40% for Communicative English and Elective modules.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Students shall strictly observe professional conduct and high standards of discipline.
2. Students should maintain decorum and dignity in the College, Hospital & Hostel.
3. As per clause 7 of the Rules and Regulations of the University and Judgment of Honorable Courts regarding the conduct of students in campus, the management has the right to stall organizational activities of students' organization directly or through their member students in the campus. An undertaking to this effect be given by the students and their parents at the time of admission.

4. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the College and Hostel campus. If any incident of ragging occurs, strict action will be taken as per the latest direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
5. Use of mobile phone by the students is strictly prohibited in class, clinics and during working hours. If found in use, it will be confiscated.
6. Use of drugs / smoking / alcoholism etc. are strictly prohibited in class / compound / clinics /hostel. Any violation lead to dismissal from the College.
7. Any type of indisciplinary behavior (whistling, passing comments, exhibiting posters, spreading rumors, shouting etc.) towards teachers, other students or staff will not be tolerated and will be subjected to major disciplinary actions.
8. Any change in the contact address / telephone number should be informed to the College immediately. College will not be responsible for any delay /non receipt of information /communication due to the change in address.
9. The institution shall not be liable in the delay / loss in communication owing to failure of postal / courier service.
10. Each student should report for class / clinical in the specified time. Late comers will not be allowed to attend class / clinics.
11. Students should inform class coordinator / concerned teacher about any inability to attend classes and should submit the leave letter in time. Absenteeism from class / clinics without prior information will be marked as double absence along with other disciplinary actions.

UNIFORM

Students are to follow dress code strictly in class and clinical area as specified by the institution.

HOSTEL

Hostel facility is available for the girl students. Annual hostel fee is Rs. 45,000/-, it may change according to the fluctuations of prices of commodities in the market.

- Admission to College Hostel will be according to the availability.
- The whole year Hostel fee should be remitted before the starting of every Academic Year.
- Hostel's Caution deposit (One Time) is Rs. 10,000/-. (Refundable at the end of stay subject to no dues certificate).
- Hostel Policy should abide by all the Hostel's inmates. Students are to follow dress code strictly hostel campus as specified by the institution.

MESS FACILITY

- Hostel inmates will get mess facility.
- Mess fees will collect according to the fluctuations of prices of commodities in the market.
- The Mess/Canteen dues of current Month will have to be settled before 5th of next month.

SHORT TERM COURSES OR TRAINING

The short-term training or courses conducted by the institution in association with other institutions or organizations shall have separate course fee in accordance with the expenditures involved.
